# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Can missing work still be completed?

Yes! Students have the entire term to turn in any assignment that was completed during the term at no penalty to them. Once the term is finished, students will not be able to turn in those missing assignments.

### What can my child do to improve his/her grade?

Most students find that missing work has the biggest impact when it comes to grades. Completing work shows the teacher what they know and adds to their overall percentage. It also helps to prepare for tests and quizzes. Extra credit is posted on my website. Students are able to complete 2 extra credit assignments per quarter (3 points each, 6 points total)

My student has turned in all their work and is still struggling. What can they do?

I am always available by appointment before school starting at 7:30 or after school.

You are welcome to make appointments via e-mail, through my website or talk to me in person

My student does not test well. What can she/he do to improve their test grades? If your student has failed a test, I will allow students to retake tests for a maximum grade of a 65%. In order to retake a test, the student must complete a "request to retest" form and make an appointment with me for remediation. This is their responsibility. I do however; strongly suggest that students use their notes, review guides and classroom tools as support for preparing for a test.
